MINUTES OF AUGUST 2, 2022
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
Town Hall – 7:00 P.M.

PRESENT: Warren Luedke, Jack Hanke, Glen Kruschke, Roger Rortvedt, Gary Vanderkin, Atty. Hughes, Debra Schwind and the Public.

The August 2, 2022, Regular Town Board Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and was called to order by Chairman Luedke.

A motion was made by Roger Rortvedt and seconded by Jack Hanke to approve the minutes from the July 5, 2022 Regular Town Board Meeting. **Motion Carried**

No one present from the Sheriff's Department

Fire Chief Ryan Pafford report that engine 20 went in for repairs and routine maintenance.

A motion was made by Gary Vanderkin and seconded by Roger Rortvedt to Adopt Ordinance NO. 3 of 2022 reducing the speed limit in the Elkhart Moraine subdivision. **Motion Carried**

A motion was made by Roger Rortvedt and seconded by Glen Kruschke to approve changing the LRIP – from Hickory Tree to Superior Ave. **Motion Carried**

The Town Board reviewed the budgeting numbers for road work from Sheboygan County Highway Department for Woodside Lane, Riverview Ct., and Hickory Tree. The estimates for the three roads were \$108,763 for grinding off, re blacktopping and marking. The Town will work with the Town of Rhine to coordinate timing of Hickory Tree since it is a road that we share.

A motion was made by Glen Kruschke and seconded by Roger Rortvedt to approve a membership to the Municipal Treasurers Association of Wisconsin for the Town Treasurer. **Motion Carried**

A motion was made by Jack Hanke and seconded by Roger Rortvedt to approve the Debra Schwind to attend the MTAW Conference and pay the expense. **Motion Carried**

The Board of Review meeting is September 6, 2022 at 6:30 pm, set Board of Review date for October 19, 2022.

October 17, 2022 was the date set for the budget workshop.

Town Hall will be closed August 25 - September 5, 2022.

Chairman Luedke gave an update on the roads; Seal Coating has been completed for the year. The County is still working on a solution for a driveway apron on Jennifer Dr. Crack filling should begin Mid-August. Three bridges are due for Seal Coating, this will cost approximately \$1500 - \$2000 per bridge and is done on a rotating basis. Ditch cutting has been complete in many areas and looks good.

Atty. Hughes had nothing to report this month.

There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Gary Vanderkin and seconded by Glen Kruschke to approve and pay the bills. **Motion Carried**

A motion was made by Roger Rortvedt and seconded by Glen Kruschke to adjourn the meeting. **Motion Carried**
